#### Ashgabat Airport

In 2016, Ashgabat completed the construction of a stunningly beautiful, modern, comfortable and ergonomic airport. This air harbor has not only become another architectural attraction of Ashgabat, but also listed in the Guinness Book of Records for the world's largest architectural image of carpet gel on the roof of the passenger terminal. This is the Turkmen national ornament of deep historical and spiritual significance for the Turkmen people.

This international airport is evidence of Turkmenistan's rapid development. 28 telescopic gangways can accept a great number of flights. The airport was awarded several international certificates and prizes and may receive and conduct about 20 million passengers a year! It complies with IATA Class A service standards.







DAYS	PROGRAM
Day 1. ARRIVAL DAY. ASHGABAT AIRPORT.	Arrival by flight TK early in the morning. Transfer to hotel. Early check-in and short rest. City tour, with visits of Ertogrul Gazy Mosque, Independence Park, Neutrality Arch, National Museum, Nissa (UNESCO) and Turkmenbashi Mosque-Mausoleum.
Day 2. ASHGABAT - DARWAZA	Half-day city tour including visits to Anau mosque ruins, Ahalteke horse stables, Central bazaar. Transfer to Darwaza in the Karakum desert, visit Erbent desert community on the way. BBQ dinner.Overnight in tents.
Day 3 DARWAZA - BCP SHAVAT - KHIVA	After camp style breakfast direct transfer to the border post Shavat. Arrival before or after lunch break at post. Transfer to hotel. Have a dinner. Overnight in hotel.
Day 4. KHIWA	City tour in Khiva, around: Ichan-Kala architectural complex (XII-XIX), Ismail Khodja Mausoleum, Muhammed Amin Khan Madrassah, Kunya-Ark Castle (XVI-XVI), Kalta Minor Tower, Tash-Hovli Palace (XIX), Pahlavan Mahmud Mausoleum(XIV-XVIII), Juma Mosque (X) Narrow streets, carved "ayvans" veranda and doors, majestic minarets and mausoleums. Leisure time and overnight at the hotel.
Day 5. KHIWA - BUKHARA	After breakfast, transfer (6-7 hours) to Bukhara through the Red desert "Kyzyl-Kum". Upon Arrival short city tour. Overnight at the hotel.
Day 6. BUKHARA - SAMARKAND	After breakfast, city tour. Bukhara, home of Ibn Sino (Avicenna), beloved city of the philosopher Hodja Nasriddin. Transfer to railway station for train to Samarkand. Arrival Samarkand and hotel check-in.
Day 7. SAMARKAND - TASHKENT	Full day city tour in Samarkand: Registan Square - Madrassah Ulug Bek (XV), Madrassah Shir-Dor (XVII), Madrassah Tillya-Kori (XVII), Mausoleum Gur Emir - Tamerlane's Tomb (XIV-XV), Bibi Khanum Mosque (XIVXV). Visiting of morning East Siab Bazaar. Transfer to train station. Train to Tashkent. Arrival in Tashkent overnight at the hotel.
Day 8. TASHKENT BP – OYBEK – KHUDJAND	Morning city tour around Tashkent: the State Museum of Applied Arts of Uzbekistan, visiting the religious complex Khasti Imam. Border formalities and meeting with guide and driver at the Oybek border. Drive towards Khujand – the centre of Sugd region, second capital of Tajikistan. Lunch upon arrival. Later visits to museum which is located next to the famous fortress of the city. In addition to market to our gaze at mausoleum Shaikh Maslehatoddina 14th century. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.
Day 9. KHUDJAND - DUSHANBE	After breakfast drive to Dushanbe – the capital city of Tajikistan. Hotel check in. Later visit of Hissar fortress - one of the lord's palaces of the Bukhara Emirate (110km, 3hrs). This fortress is surrounded by monuments and mausoleums XVII-XVIII centuries. Evening excursion, walking in the Independence Square, where you can see the flagpole, which entered to the Records of Guinness Book as the tallest flagpole in the world (H165m), a monument of the funder of first tajik state - Ismail Somoni and a building of the biggest library in Central Asia, 9 floor, with over 11 million books.
Day 10. DUSHANBE - ALMATY (flight)	After breakfast, transfer to airport for flight to Almaty. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel. Have a rest. Drive to Big Almaty Lake (opt). Dinner at local restaurant. Overnight in hotel.
Day 11. ALMATY	After breakfast, start city tour in Almaty: visit Park of 28 Panfilov Guardsmen, Zenkov Cathedral, Museum of Kazakh National Musical Instruments, Green Bazaar. PM. Visiting Central Mosque, Republic Square and Square of First President. Drive to Kok-Tube Hill and take a cable Car and have the best panoramic view.
Day 12. ALMATY - KARAKOL	After breakfast, drive to Karakol via Kazakh-Kyrgyz border Kegen. En route excursion to Charyn Canyon. Upon arrival to Karakol dinner at local café, overnight at hotel.
Day 13. KARAKOL - BISHKEK	After breakfast, drive to Bishkek. En route possible to stop in Cholpon-Ata and have a boat cruise (should be paid supplementary) stop at Burana Tower of XI Century - remains of the ancient city of Balasagun. Upon arrival to Bishkek dinner at local café, overnight at the hotel.
Day 14. BISHKEK – ALA- ARCHA	After breakfast, city tour, including visiting of History Museum, Central Square Ala-Too, Panfilov Park. Then drive to National Park Ala-Archa for easy walk. Drive back to Bishkek and visit Osh bazaar. Dinner at local restaurant with Folkl Music Show. Overnight at the hotel.
Day 15 DEPARTURE DAY	After early breakfast, transfer to Bishkek International Airport "Manas" for departure Flight.



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#### Kyrgyz Taigan

The Kyrgyz Taigan is very old indigenous breed of dog, which mentioned in the Kyrgyz epics. It is well known, that these animals accompanied nomadic people even before our era. As in ancient times, today the Kyrgyz still use greyhound Taigan for hunting, and co-hunt with a bird of prey - golden eagle. Taigan help to chase foxes, badgers, rams, goats and sometimes-even wolves. The name of the breed - «Taigan» means «unstoppable» in Kyrgyz.


The Taigan is considered as a national breed of Kyrgyzstan, and not well known outside the country. One rarely can see them at exhibitions.

The Kyrgyz Greyhound has a wonderful character. Taigans are very attentive and obedient. Of course, they need training, but it is a pleasure to train them. They learn new orders with interest and quickly understand what is required from them. At the same time, the taigan can be proud and inclined to show independence. This dog, despite thousands of years of friendship with people, is still quite independent. In particularly difficult times, the Kyrgyz people could survive with the help of Taigans' hunt. Not surprisingly, sometimes Kyrgyz greyhounds amaze with their serenity and ability to make decisions independently.





DAYS	PROGRAM
Day 1. ARRIVAL DAY	Meet the group at Bishkek International "Manas" Airport. Transfer to hotel for rest. After lunch, city tour of Bishkek.
Day 2. BISHKEK - CHON-KEMIN	After breakfast, drive to Chon-Kemin valley. En route visit Burana Tower. Lunch en route. Upon arrival free time for walking. Dinner and overnight in guest house.
Day 3. CHON- KEMIN - TASH- RABAT	After breakfast, drive to Tash-Rabat caravanserai, which is a well preserved 15th century stone caravanserai in Naryn region. Dinner and overnight in a yurt camp.
Day 4. TASH- RABAT - SON- KUL	After breakfast, drive to Son-kul. Lunch in Naryn. Son-kul is an alpine lake in northern Naryn Province. The altitude of the lake 3016m. Upon arrival to Son-kul, hiking around yurt camps. Dinner and overnight in Yurts.
Day 5. SON-KUL - KYZYL-OI	After breakfast, drive to Kyzyl-Oi village. Kyzyl-Oi is quite different from the other mountain villages in Kyrgyzstan. It existed even before the October Revolution in 1917, and has therefore kept its distinct Central Asian character with its reddish clay houses. After lunch you can ride on horses (opt.) to gorge and enjoy magnificent view of Kokomeren River. Dinner and overnight at local house.
Day 6. KYZYL-OI - KYZYL-TUU - BOKONBAEVO	After breakfast, drive to Bokonbaev village in Issyk-Kul region. En route stop in Kochkor for master class of Uzbek food "Plov" and Kyrgyz bread "Kattama". Further drive to Kyzyl-Tuu village, which is a fascinating destination for those interested in Kyrgyz nomadic culture who would like to see the yurt installation and demonstration of how to set it up. Then drive to Bokonbaev village. Upon arrival is possible to have a master class of national soup "Shorpo" with "Samsy" (opt).
Day 7. BOKONBAEVO - JETI-OGUZ - KARAKOL	After breakfast, you can see Eagle-hunting show (opt.). Then drive to Karakol town. En route visit Barskoon and Djeti-Oguz Gorges and have easy trek. Upon arrival in Karakol, to take part in a master class of cooking Uigur "Lagman" with "laza" sause.
Day 8. KARAKOL - ISSYK-KUL	After breakfast, short city tour in Karakol. Then drive to Cholpon- Ata, visit history museum and petroglyphs. Possible boat cruise (opt.).
Day 9. ISSYK-KUL - BISHKEK	After breakfast, drive to Bishkek. En route lunch at local café near Tokmok town. Upon arrival, check in the hotel and leisure time. Dinner.
Day 10. Departure Day. Bishkek Airport	Transfer to airport. See the group off.





## KYRGYZ FLOWER WATCHING TOUR 12 DAYS

Kyrgyzstan is famous for its mountainous scenery and a big variety of mountain flowers. More than 90 % of Kyrgyzstan's territory is mountainous and over 40% exceeding 3000 meters above Sea level. In these high altitudes, are growing Edelweiss, a flower of wind chimes bell, a flower of forget-me-not, a flower of the Genus Otocillus, a cornflower, a flower of purple Syringa, Hibiscus syriacus. There are plenty of flowers of Salvia officinalis, Camellia sinensis, red poppies etc.

The best time of a year for flower-lovers are spring and the beginning of summer. This part of the season, give us a great opportunity to watch different kind of tulips, chamomiles, poppies, snowdrops, Edelweiss and other kind of flowers. All the tours for flower watching are guided by experienced Flower guides, arranging the best season and places to visit. Our journey will take place in a very beautiful picturesque places as: Chon-Kemin gorge, Son-Kul Lake, Jergalan Village, Altyn-Arashan Spa Area, Tash-Rabat Caravan Sarai, Chatyr-Kul Lake and At Bashi, Bosogo Valley.

#### Edelweiss

For people of the mountains, Edelweiss flower is a symbol of happiness and love, and even there is a very beautiful and sad legend about its origin. The passionate hearts of two lovers could not live without each other. Fate has ordered differently they had to separate from each other. Both of them were horrifying with the thought of the coming separation. The only way to stay together they found to die together and jumped off the cliff. After their death, the rocks covered with white flowers of Edelweiss...Since then; for mountain peoples- Edelweiss have become a symbol of courage and steadfastness.

Edelweiss is Noble white - this is how the name of this wonderful flower translated as well as that of other highland plants, is amazing and admirable. Life in the sudden changes of heat and cold. Here in such «extreme» conditions, at an altitude of more than 2000 m, among the bare rocks covered with legends beautiful edelweiss. In the highlands, it forms single bumps, and on mountain meadows stretches a beautiful carpet. The genus of Edelweiss includes about 40 species with many common features, but the most famous of them is the Edelweiss Alpine, a low herbaceous plant with baskets surrounded by white radiant leaves, which makes the inflorescences look like stars carved from thin white felt. The height of the peduncle is 15-25 cm. Leaves are petiolate, narrow, long, green from above and white-fronted from below.

Day 3. CHON-KEMIN – ISSYK-KUL LAKE	After breakfast, drive to Lake Issyk Kul - the 2nd largest high mountainous lake in the world. Lunch on the way. Upon arrival, a boat cruise with unforgettable view of the lake (opt.). Dinner and overnight at the hotel.	
Day 4. ISSYK-KUL – JERGALAN VILLAGE	After breakfast, drive to the village Jergalan. Lunch in guest house. After lunch, take a trip around the guesthouse. Enjoy flower watching and horseback riding (opt.). Then you can watch the Yurt installation show (opt.) and have a frog therapy. Dinner and overnight in guesthouse.	
Day 5. JERGALAN – ALTYN-ARASHAN VALLEY	After breakfast, drive to Altyn-Arashan hot spring valley at 3800 m altitude. Here you can enjoy the thermal bath and watch the flowers. Dinner and overnight in tents.	
Day 6. ALTYN- Arashan – Kochkor	After breakfast, drive to Bokonbaevo on the southern shore of Issyk-Kul Lake. Enjoy the Eagle Hunting Show (opt.). After lunch in local Kyrgyz family, drive to the village of Kochkor. Dinner and overnight in local house.	
Day 7. KOCHKOR – SON-KUL LAKE	After breakfast, drive to the 2nd largest lake in Kyrgyzstan - Son-Kullake. Cross the mountain pass and enjoy a breathtaking view of the grassland highland plants along the road. Upon arrival, dinner and overnight in yurts. Horse riding is optional.	1 KAP
Day 8. SON-KUL - AT- BASHI – TASH-RABAT	After breakfast, drive to Naryn through Dolon pass and arrive at At-Bashi. Lunch in local cafe/house. After lunch visit the «Bosogo» gorge. Then drive to Tash-Rabat Caravanserai. Dinner and overnight in yurts.	
Day 9. TASH-RABAT – CHATYR-KOL LAKE	After breakfast, drive to the 3rd largest lake in Kyrgyzstan - Chatyr-Kol lake. Lunch with lunch-boxes. Enjoy alpine plants near the Chatyr-Kol lake at 3350m altitude. Dinner and overnight in tents.	
Day 10. CHATYR-KOL LAKE – NARYN	After breakfast, drive to Naryn city. On the way lunch at local house or cafe. After arriving in Naryn you have a nice trip to the Salkyn-Tor Gorge. Watch flowers in the gorge. Overnight in guesthouse in Naryn.	
Day 11. NARYN – BISHKEK	After breakfast, drive to Bishkek. Lunch on the way in Kochkor. Dinner at local restaurant in Bishkek. Overnight in hotel.	
Day 12. DEPARTURE	After breakfast transfer to Bishkek airport for home flight. After all formalities, see the group off.	





## BAIKONUR SPACEPORT TOUR 6 DAYS

#### Nur-Sultan•Kyzyl-Orda•Bakonur•Almaty•Charyn Canyon•Almaty

Baikonur tour is a special offer. Just imagine, in Soviet times Baikonur was a closed military town, and spaceport was the most secret. Today, there is a great opportunity to learn about the history of the astronautics, see the samples of real missiles, spaceships and meet the people who dedicated their life to the Space Exploration.

Baikonur Spaceport tour consists of three parts: first destination, Nur-Sultan (Astana), brand new capital of Kazakhstan, ultra-modern metropolis and is the northernmost capital city in Asia. Second visiting is Baikonur town and the Museum of history of astronautics and visit to the Baikonur space center itself. There you can see launching platforms and hangars, as well as the museum of astronautics with the real space shuttle Buran where you can try to take the hold of controls. Third, Almaty- the southern capital of Kazakhstan, it is in the center of the Eurasian continent, at the foothills of the Trans-Ili Ala-Tau Mountains, the northernmost ridge of the Tien Shan Mountains. From Almaty there is one-day trip to the Charyn Canyon, where you will have an unforgettable view of a huge gorge with cliffs and of various colors and shades.

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#### TOUR INFORMATION



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Baikonur is a city of Russian Federation, located in Kyzylorda Region, in the southern Kazakhstan

Russia rented the city and spaceport, until 2050 from Kazakhstan, annually paying about 200 million dollars. Therefore, Baikonur is the territory of Russia. The Russian laws are in force here, the Roubles are official currency, and city authorities functioning like in Russia and different from Kazakhstan. On the central square, there is still a statue of Lenin; most of them taken away to the outskirts of Kazakh cities. To get to Baikonur, you need to get a special permission. It can be issued either through acquaintances (if you have them in this city), or with the assistance of travel agencies. There are also organizations that can act as a host party and take all the hassle of processing documents on their own, contenting themselves with a reasonable fee.

Everything in the city remind spaceport: the name of shops, restaurants, with a dozen advertising posters and banners, with Yuri Gagarin smiles. The world's first man in an open space became a brand here. Baikonur is a city where every house is involved in space exploration.



PROGRAM
Arrival in Nur-Sultan (Astana), the capital city of Kazakhstan. Nur-Sultan sightseeing tour including the Constitution Square, Presidential Centre of Culture of the Republic of Kazakhstan, shopping center Khan Shatyr, "Astana-Baiterek" monument, the Kazakh Eli Square, Khazret Sultan mosque and Palace of Independence. Overnight at the hotel.
Early breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to airport for flight Astana– Kyzylorda. Arrival to the Kyzylorda airport, transfer to the train station (Train #41 Kyzylorda-Baikonur). Arrival to the train station of Baikonur. Meeting, transfer to the hotel. Overnight at the hotel.
Baikonur city tour and visit Spaceport History Museum, "Buran" Orbital complex. Transfer to the site number 254. Report of the crew to the State Commission. Transfer to the site number 1, visit to the "Gagarin's start" complex. Transfer to the city. Overnight in Baikonur.
Early check out, transfer to the train station (Train #24 EOD Baikonur-Kyzylorda). Arrival to Kyzylorda, transfer to the airport, have a flight Kyzylorda – Almaty. PM arrival to Almaty airport, transfer to hotel. Overnight in hotel.
After breakfast drive to the Charyn Canyon – along the Charyn River, 200 kilometers (125 mi) east of Almaty, close to the Chinese border. The canyon is 80 kilometers (50mi) in length. Walking through the Canyons. Drive back to Almaty. Overnight in hotel. Transfer to airport. See the group off.







## KAZAKHSTAN & KYRGYZSTAN INDUSTRIAL TOUR 8 DAYS

#### Almaty•Bishkek•Tokmok•Balykchy•Cholpon-Ata•Karakol•Bishkek

Kazakhstan is a fantastic destination for an industrial tour. The country is rich in mineral resources and in some categories of mining Kazakhstan is among the world leaders. The territory and economy of Kazakhstan is the largest in Central Asia, both absolute and per capita. The main industrial attraction of the tour will be an excursion to confectionery and distillery factories, degustation of national drinks, made out of camels' and mares' milk.

A visit to Kyrgyzstan with an industrial focus is a unique experience. First, Kyrgyzstan is a mountainous country and its economy mostly relies on power industry. Secondly, the growth of industrial production is increasing mainly due to light industry, especially by an increasing production in the textile industry: the production of clothing, footwear and other leather products. There is furthermore an interesting project supported by a Japanese regional development program, the "one villageone product"-project, which is a great impact for local communities' development. There are many manufacturing units all over regions in Kyrgyzstan making souvenirs and goods of a high quality. Planned excursions to the well-known local factories producing national drinks and sweets.

The combination of these herbs, which contain a huge amount of vitamins, gives honey a healing power.

Issyk-Kul honey due to its special climate conditions has a special smell and taste and people collect various kinds of this product. These are: field, sainfoin, herbal, mountain and alpine honey. The most common is sainfoin honey, collected from clover. A rare, very valuable honey collected from thyme, oregano. They grow in the highland area. It is dark and delicious.

area. It is dark and delicious. This type of honey increases the body's resistance to colds and infectious diseases, helps to restore performance in case of mental and physical fatigue. It has a special fragrant smell and thick consistency.



Remarkably, today there are more than 7500 thousand varieties of apples in the world. Apple orchards occupy an incredibly large area of 5 million he ctares. Thus, almost every second fruit tree is an apple tree. Apples of Issyk-Kul Province occupy a very special place in all this fruit diversity, which is eloquently proved by many facts. One of the reason favorable geographical location and moderate sea climate. These very significant facts give domestic apples a unique taste and unique chemical composition.

«Excellent» sort of Issyk-Kul apples. Its name speaks for itself. Back in the 20-30s, this apple came to Kyrgyzstan from America, settled down and proved itself perfectly.

The «excellent» sort is winter-resistant, has exceptionally elegant coloring, very delicate skin, aromatic, and sour flesh. It is important to note that Issyk-Kul apples of this sort have a high yield and, most importantly, a unique tart taste. These fruits grow in highland gardens and watered from the purest mountain rivers. Usually apples of «Excellent» sort are average size, but under favorable conditions sometimes reach 250 grams. Ripe by September and can be stored almost until June.



#### How to cook Central Asian Plov

So many cooks, so many plov recipes.

Rice- this is the main stumbling block for all the cooks who have ever-cooked plov. However, almost all of them agree that the best is Batken rice, as well as other varieties. types of rice, but preferably not too starchy. Meat- Lamb traditionally used for plov, but beef is also suitable.

ingredients: onions and carrots. Different

Oil- Plov cooked using either vegetable oil, refined sunflower oil.

Plov is a fat dish. On average, about 200-250 ml of oil used per 1 kg of rice.

Spices - we can highlight more or less traditional seasonings: garlic (slightly peeled off and put in whole

heads);Spicy red pepper (laid with a whole pod); zira; barberry; ground black or red pepper.

The basic principle of ploy is to fry meat Then all the ingredients are poured with hot water. It should cover the meat by 1-2 cm. Then garlic, a pod of red pepper, spices and other ingredients are placed. Everything is salted to taste and cooked on moderate heat for at least 40 minutes before softening the

The Holy Mountain "Sulaiman Too" in Osh is perhaps the most significant, and almost certainly the best-known religious pilgrimage site in Central Asia. In 2009, it was the first mountain to be included in the UNESCO World Heritage List. In no other single place of Central Asia, you can find such a concentration of sacred sights; that people are visiting. People are uttering a prayer to have children, being healthy and wish for happiness from God, on the top of the Mountain. Suleiman Too, is also well known for being Central Asian Hajj destination for Muslim pilgrims before going to Mecca. The Valley of Sacred Springs of Manzhyl-Ata is located on the southern shore of Issyk-Kul lake. The name Manzhyl-Ata comes from the name of the visionary, who spread Islam among the local population. There are 8 sacred willows here, near which those miraculous springs are sheltered: 12 springs. Each spring has its own name and unique properties. Mineral deposits and underground waters give the area a unique energy, completing the miraculous image of the valley.

Today, pilgrimages enjoy the pure healing water - all this can be done in the wonderful Manzhyl-Ata valley.


#### Sulaiman-Too

Sulaiman-Too is a symbol of Osh city and main Holy site for Muslims. Since ancient times, until nowadays, Sulaiman Too considered being one of the most sacred places for Muslims, since time immemorial, this place is considered sacred, for the present Muslims, a three-time visit to Sulaiman-Too is equal to the Hajj in Mecca of Saudi Arabia.

In the distant past, Sulaiman-Too served as a landmark for travelers who considered it sacred. This ancient monument of art and history has been known since time immemorial. Up until the XVI century, the mountain was called Bara-Kuh, afterwards it was renamed into Tahti-Suleiman, which means «the throne of Solomon». This sacred mountain was called until the XX century, and nowadays it is called Sulaiman-Toothe Mountain of Sulaiman.

The mountain has always had a cult meaning for believers, especially for fire worshipers. Some historians believe that the prophet of Zoroastrianism Zatushtura who lived and worked on his theories in one of the caves of Sulaiman-Too. There was also one of the temples of the Zoroastrian cult of water and fire. It is possible that the name of the city of Osh comes from these words - Ohcho, Yakhsha-Osh. Until now, the mountain keeps a lot of valuable and surprising information - hundreds of petroglyphs are carved on stone slabs, walls of caves and grottoes.

In 2009, the sacred mountain Sulaiman-Too was inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List.

Day 4. SHAKH FASIL-KAZARMAN	Breakfast. Departure to Zhalalabad. Visit to the Safed Bulan and Shah Fasil Mausoleum. Continue to Kazarman. Overnight stay in a local house.
Day 5. Kazarman-Son- Kul	Breakfast. Departure to the pearl of Kyrgyzstan - Lake Son-Kul. Lake Son-Kul lies at an altitude of 3,016 meters above sea level. Overnight in the traditional nomadic yurts.
Day 6. SON-KUL- TASH-RABAT	Breakfast. Horse riding around the Son Kul lake. Afternoon departure to Tash-Rabat, a well-preserved 15th century caravanserai in the At Bashy district of Naryn Province. Tash-Rabat is located at an altitude of 3,000 meters. In the south is the Chatyr-Kul Lake and the Torugart Pass. In the north Koshoy Korgon, a castle ruin of unknown age. The area is a popular destination for hiking and horse riding. Afterwards dinner and overnight in a yurt camp.
Day 7. TASH- RABAT-TAMGA	Breakfast. Departure to Tamga. The village is located on the southern shore of Issyk-Kul Lake. Drive along the southern side of Issyk-Kul Lake. Visit of the holy place Manzhyl-Ata. Overnight stay in guest house.
Day 8. TAMGA- KARAKOL	Breakfast. Departure to Karakol. On the way excursion in Jeti-Oguz gorge. Easy hike. After arrival in Karakol, city tour: Dungan Mosque, Russian Orthodox Church. Visit to the museum of the famous Traveller M.V. Prejvalskiy. Overnight at the hotel.

#### «Baiterek»

«Baiterek» is a national monument in Nur-Sultan city. The idea to build the monument belongs to the former President of Kazakhstan, Nursultan Nazarbayev's initial plan for Baiterek was born on an ordinary paper napkin, and the head of state drew a plan for futuristic design.

Today, this napkin is stored in the Museum of the First President in Nur-Sultan, along with other exhibits - scientific works, awards, gifts related to the activities of the leader of the nation.

The monument «Baiterek» has a deep philosophical meaning, reflecting the views of ancient nomads. The Ishim River represents the World River, where on the bank grows "Baiterek"- Tree of Life. Baiterek means «high poplar tree» in English.

Baiterek serves as a model of the Universe: the underground world corresponds to the roots, the earthly world - the trunk, and the heavenly world - the crown. The huge gilded glass sphere in diameter of 22 meters, crowning a design, symbolizes golden egg, which is laid in a tree crown by the bird of happiness "Samruk". The height of the monument «Baiterek» is also symbolic: 97 meters (without a ball) mark the transfer of the capital from Almaty to Astana in 1997.

Baiterek Monument, the cultural centre of Astana, embodying the idea of a future-oriented state, and has utilitarian significance.

#### Too-Ashuu Pass

The famous Too-Ashuu Pass is located in the Tian-Shan Mountain ranges on the Bishkek-Osh strategic motorway, which connects the northern and southern Provinces of Kyrgyzstan. The height of the pass is 3,400 meters above sea level.

The tunnel on the top of the pass constructed in 1962. Prior to its construction, the upper point of the road was almost 500 meters higher. The length of the tunnel is 2.2 kilometers.

On the northern slope, there is a medical center for people suffering from asthma. Clean mountain air has a beneficial effect on the respiratory system.

After the tunnel, Suusamyr valley starts. On the southern slope of Too-Ashuu at an altitude of 3,000 meters, there is a popular ski and snowboard resort with the similar name.

The road across the pass takes no more than two hours from Bishkek, but in winter the journey is noticeably difficult due to the complexity of the road - it has more than twenty steep turns.

There are many legends associated with the pass, and one of them tells about the famous Kyrgyz strong man "Kojomkul". The legend tells the story of how Kojomkul could carry his horse over the pass, on his shoulders, when his horse was not able to walk anymore. People didn't forget that noble deed and for the story, there is a monument In Bishkek, Kojomkul carrying his horse.



## Palace of Peace and Reconciliation in Nur-Sultan

In 2006, a magnificent pyramid appeared in the capital of Kazakhstan. Indeed, the Palace of Peace and Reconciliation is a delightful building that not only amazes with its originality and grandeur, but also has great significance for the Kazakh people, symbolizing friendship, unity and peace.

The idea belongs to the first president of Kazakhstan, Nursultan Nazarbayev

- proposed to build a new building for holding congresses with the leaders of world and traditional religions.

The pyramid symbolizes three basic concepts of many religions: dungeon in dark colors; middle part in white colors symbolizes peace; sky - glass top of the pyramid.

The construction project led by famous British architect Norman Foster. The opening of the Palace of Peace and Reconciliation took place on September 1, 2006 and accompanied by the performance of the world opera star Monserrat Caballe on the stage of the concert and opera hall. In addition to the opera hall in burgundy and gold tones, equipped with the most

modern technical equipped with the most modern technical equipment, inside the pyramid there are conference halls, a press center, a hall for solemn ceremonies, several exhibition rooms and a center of modern art.

The Cheops Atrium Hall is the largest space, with more than 2,000 square meters of space and 4 galleries, one of which houses the large-scale composition of Nur-Sultan's Main Plan 2030.

In the center of modern art you can see various works of art, visit a temporary exhibition or a creative meeting with artists from Kazakhstan and abroad.

Aktau is located in the western part of Kazakhstan, on the Mangyshlak peninsula and is administrative center of Mangystau. In Kazakh language, Aktau means "White Mountain". It is the most popular slot canyons in western Kazakhstan, which were formed by rushing rain and floodwater, which carried sand, slicing through a mesa and carving the mystical sandstone walls.

Aktau- are Chalk Mountains that are more than 400 million years old. The mountains are white, but there are also blue, pink and green slopes. Only a bird's eye view or detailed tracking reveals the extraordinary beauty of the place. Also Aktau is called the «Moon» because of its unusual colour.



#### Aktau city on the Caspian Sea Shore

Aktau city- the center of Mangistau, former Mangishlak Province located in the southwest of Kazakhstan. In 1961, founded as Aktau settlement. From 1964 to 1991, renamed into the city of Shevchenko in honor of the Ukrainian poet who was exiled to Kazakhstan in the 19th century.

The city foundation connected with the creation of a nuclear shield in the second half of the 20th century in the territory of the Soviet Union. Several enterprises worked on extraction of uranium ore with its subsequent processing and enrichment on site. At the same time, residential houses were erected, and the city's infrastructure was developed, which provided normal living conditions for the city's residents in an environment of arid desert.

In the 90s of the 20th century, after the Soviet Union collapse, Aktau became oil and gas fields development center, with addition newly discovered; Kalamkas, Zhetybai, Arman, Dunga, Komsomol and Oymasha sites.

Aktau has harsh continental climate with dry, hot summers and cold winters. Due to the lack of fresh water natural sources, the citizens of Aktau are provided with drinking water from a water-desalted station.

The city has a seaport and an airport. The sea port of Aktau is the only one port of Kazakhstan, which serves for international transportation, oil, oil products, and various cargoes. Since 1963, the main purpose of the port was to transport oil and uranium products by sea.

The tourist season on the coast starts in June and lasts until the end of August. There are several recreation centers and equipped beaches, nightclubs, cafes and restaurants in the city. As well as cinemas, a puppet theatre and a musical drama theatre. Also modern hotels of different categories, where everyone can choose a suitable option of accommodation.

Chalk Cliffs are scoured and riddled with deep channels forming innumerable ranges of fantastic columns. Lunch and dinner in field conditions, overnight in tents in Tuzbair.

Bozzhira relict mountains, like chameleons, change their appearance as you walk between them. These relicts, like silent guards, peer into the hazy distance guarding the peace of the majestic symbol of Mangystau – the giant stone yurt. The true master of the yurt is the lonely wind mournfully singing the steppe songs to the endless skies. Meals in field conditions, overnight in tents in Bozzhira.



#### Altyn Emel National Park

A tourist who once visited Altyn Emel Park will remember for life the incredible landscapes that open up to his eyes. On a relatively small area, there are so many absolutely different landscapes.

On a rather compact territory of Altyn-Emel several absolutely different geological objects are presented at once. All this is not only fascinatingly beautiful, but also ancient. Geological layers, formed 600 million years ago, have been preserved and presented here to this day. An area of 520,000 hectares is intended for the conservation of rare species of animals and plants.

On the territory of the Park, there are several historical monuments - Scythian (Saks') burial mounds of Bes-Shatyr, dating back to the 1st millennium BC and Tamgaly Tas with ancient rock images, the earliest of which are attributed to the 16-14 centuries BC. Here, on the right bank of the Ili River, is the famous Singing Dunes. This sandy mountain, about 3 km long and 80 m tall, has unusual properties. In summer, when strong wind blows or tourists leave it, the mountain emits a powerful, vibrating rumble. Nearby are trees: turanga and jigid, various types of shrubs: willow, honeysuckle, Ionian barberry and there is a spring. In the steppe grows black saxaul, and on the slopes of Singing Barkhan there are thickets of white saxaul.

Going on safari you will see a lot of animals: Siberian mountain goats - Teke, desert gazelles - Jeiran, wild horses -Kulans, mountain rams - arkars, as well as wolves, foxes, golden eagles, bearded vultures, mountain partridge - Keklik and many others, most of them are listed in the World and Kazakhstan Red Books.



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

#### **Celestial Mountains**

More than 90% of Kyrgyzstan territory covered by mountains, and for good reason Kyrgyzstan called the country of celestial mountains. The uniqueness of Kyrgyzstan, on a small territory the highest peaks-around seven thousands meters are concentrated. There are 40 peaks with a height of more than 6000 m and 80 peaks exceeding 5000 meters. These peaks belong mainly to the Tien Shan mountain ranges, a relatively smaller part located in the Pamirs. The name «Tien Shan» from Chinese language translated as «Celestial Mountains».

The first mention of the Tien Shan ridge appeared in ancient times. According to ancient writings and notes of travelers, expeditions to these places took place since ancient times, but all of them are now more like legends than reliable facts. The Tien Shan ridge is the longest ridge (2800 km) not only in Kyrgyzstan, but also in the whole territory of Asia, in the central part of which the highest peaks - the Pobeda Peak (7439 m), discovered in 1943, the northernmost seven-thousand peak of the planet, located on the Kyrgyz-Chinese border, east of Lake Issyk-Kul. It's called the most inaccessible, the most formidable peak of seven thousand meters - this peak makes high demands on the physical and moral preparation of the mountaineers. The history of conquering the Pobeda Peak is full of interesting facts. In 1936, a group of mountaineers climbing Khan Tengri peak, at that time considered the highest peak of the Tien Shan, noticed another mountain peak nearby, competing in height with Khan Tengri. Only after seven years later, an expedition of mountaineers discovered and conquered Pobeda Peak.

## Urumqi

Urumqi is the ancient city of Xi'an Province in China, located at the foot of Tien Shan Mountains. City was an important center of the Great Silk Road, and nowadays we can witness cultural-historical monuments from those times. In Uighur language, Urumqi means «Beautiful pasture».

The Red Hill Park in the center of Urumqi is ideal for a walk, and the main tourist destination is the red brick pagoda on top of Mount "Hunshan". The observation deck allows you to admire the panoramic views of the city and its surroundings.

To learn more about Urumqi's culture; taste the national cuisine, enjoy shopping, and buy souvenirs, we head to the Big Bazaar in the Uyghur district. There are plenty of shops and souvenir shops in the Arabianstyle marketplace, and as night falls, the bazaar turns into a street theatre to surprise everyone with a spectacular performance.

One of the stunning and dramatic scenery nearby Urumqi is "Tianchi" landscape area, which is located 100 km from Urumqi. It is famous pearl of Tien Shan, a mountain lake with crystal-clear water formed by glacier activity. In the summer months, the lake gives travelers a pleasant coolness, giving the opportunity to enjoy the nature.

Khan Tengri is a mountain in the Tian Shan mountain range. It lies on the border between China, Kyrgyzstan and Kazakhstan, east of Issyk-Kul Lake. Its geological altitude is 6,995 m (22,949 ft), but its glacier cap rises to 7,010 m (22,999 ft). For this reason, it is considered a mountain climber, including the Soviet Snow Leopard Award, as a 7,000-meter high peak. The name «Khan Tengri» means «king of heaven» and may refer to the deity Tengri. In some other local languages it is known as Khan Tangiri Shyngy, Kan-Too Chokusu (Bloody Mountain Peak), Khan-Tengri Peak and Hantengri Feng.



#### Arslanbob

According to the legend, when Alexander the Great conquered the territories of modern Fergana valley, was so impressed by the taste of walnuts from Arslanbob, which took them back to Greece. Since then, these walnuts from Arslanbob spread all over the world. Arslanbob's walnut forest is a largest walnut forest located at an altitude of 1700 meters in the mountains of the Fergana and Chatkal Ranges, in the Jalal-Abad Province, Kyrgyzstan. Total area of the forest 700 000 hectares. The forest especially stunning in the summertime and attract big number of

According to scientific reports, the age of the forest exceed millions of years. In this vast territory, grow numerous walnut trees, pistachios, almonds, cherry plums, pears and many others. The total number of plant species growing here exceeds 130. The age of some walnut trees exceeds 1000 years and each tree can bear from 150 to 400 kilograms of walnuts every year.

Apart from forest, the location is very interesting. The slopes of the Fergana and Chatkal Ranges in this place are composed of dolomite and therefore very different from other Tien Shan Mountains by their unusual color and relief. Such a large forest requires a lot of water and therefore this region is rich in numerous streams and rivers. There are several lakes and waterfalls, two popular waterfalls in the forest: small and large. The height of the large waterfall is 80 meters. It runs on the high rocky mountain range of Babash-Ata. And the height of the small waterfall is 35 meters.



#### «Darwaza» - Gas Crater


One of the most famous sightseeing Gas Crater located near Darwaza village, 270 km away from Ashgabat, the capital of Turkmenistan, in the northern direction and in extremely desert area.

The "Gates of Hell" story began in 1971. At that time, Soviet geologists carried out exploration work in Turkmenistan and found an underground gas deposit.

After numerous drills, the soil over the gas-filled void collapsed, taking away the drilling tower and the nearby transport. Luckily, people did not get hurt during the accident, but the collapse created a pit where the gas that was rising from the underground.

According to the official version, in order to prevent the gas leakage dangerous for go out. At that time, scientists made a big mistake: the deposit in this area was so large that fire has been burning continuously since 1971, and until now, almost half a century.

The government of Turkmenistan planned to fill the pit with land so that the "Gates of Hell" would close, but so far, this plan has not been implemented. Currently, the diameter of the burning pit is about 60 meters and its depth is about 20 meters.



## Symölök - Festive Meal of Central Asia

Symölök is a festive meal of Central Asian countries and the meal appears on the tables during the spring holiday Nooruz. This is a tasty and healthy meal, which cooked with great responsibility and pleasure. The main ingredient of Symölök is germinated wheat grains. Legendary dish occupies an honorable place in Kyrgyz cuisine and cooking takes a lot of time about 10 hours or even more.

Usually Symölök cooked outside in a huge "kazan" (pot). It is necessary to stir constantly, which is very difficult for one person, which is why several people, about ten or more take part in the cooking. Traditionally, during stirring, the person should have only positive thoughts; the process of cooking must have positive atmosphere, with funny songs and jokes.

Forty small stones placed on the bottom of the "kazan", preventing from burning food. Cooked with cotton oil and added nuts, dried fruits. Cooking lasts until the mass has thickened and browned.

Then an important process of spillage and distribution begins. The Symölök is distributed to everyone - children usually eagerly serve food to their neighbors.



## Kyrgyz National Game "Kok-Boru"

The most spectacular and dynamic type of sports program of the World Nomadic Games is undoubtedly the "Kok-Boru" game. In Kyrgyz language, Kok-Boru literally means «gray/blue-wolf. It is an ancient game and very popular among the peoples of Central Asia.

Until recently, there were no precise rules of the game. According to modern rules, 10 players participate in the game from one team, but only four players from each team can be on the field. Participants can be changed, also change their horses. The game consists of three games - twenty minutes each. It takes place on the field with a length of about 200 meters and a width of about 80 meters. On the sides of the field, there are gates with a diameter of about three and a half meters and a height of one and a half meters. The team has the task - to get the goat carcass from the ground and throw it into the opponents 'gate.

In the past, players could use physical force, beat opponents with a whip, but in modern times, at official competitions, the rules limit players, and for breaking the rules, they get penalty points, up to disqualification and suspension from the field.

According to the Kok-Boru rules, only stallions and male horses take part in the game. It's a tough sports game, and requires a lot of strength and skill from the players, so the average age of the official competitions players - about 20 years old.

## KYRGYZ NATIONAL HORSE GAMES IN KYRGYZSTAN!





Horses along with hunting dogs have always played a huge role in the daily life of the Kyrgyz people. They were essential not only in the hunt, but the true helpers in everyday family life. Even today the majority of the rural population in the country follow a semi-nomadic way of life. Almost everyone can ride a horse, and a variety of horse games that have been passed on from generation to generation, provide an excellent opportunity to show their riding skills, agility and prompt reaction. Today you may see games such as:

<u>Er Enish</u> - pulling the strings of the contestants, testing their strength, cleverness and toughness. Wrestling fight on horses. Confusion and the attemption of might, a few intensive minutes of superhuman effort, for the man and the horse. In the dangerous dance of movements and poses, horse battering and coward-punches – the winner takes all pride and triumph. Nevertheless the final judge in the spurt of emotions might not be explicited and it might affect backstage fights of supporters. Er-Enish is an element, unbridled like wild horses;

<u>At Chabysh</u> – races for long distances. Fascinating contests that have racing up to 100km in which often young boys of age 10-15 are involved for playfulness of horses <u>Ulak Tartysh</u> – enchanting game in which two teams of riders 'compete' for the goat carcass. Many are bewitched by the moment when the riders almost droop down and gets 30 kilo carcass while riding. Then the team should drop the carcass to the slope with an improvised ring. Kurosh – wrestling on horses, when riders should get the other rider down the horse by pushing and seizing;

<u>Oodarysh</u> - another type of wrestling where riders should get the other one off the horse without using hands. You can win only if you can skillfully ride a horse that will push the other rider, maybe even with his horse;

<u>Kyz Kuumay</u> – beautiful game, that is still hard to call a game. The rider should catch the girlrider and then he will be awarded with a kiss;

<u>Tiyin Enmey</u> – a game where the rider tries to pick up coins from ground while riding. The dates of folk games fell outside the normal "tourist season" as it was not intended as a festival for tourists but rather as a festival for local people. Majority of the participants are the people working in the mountains, who take cattle to one of the mountain jailoos (pasture) for the summertime. When the herd is down to the lower meadows, preparation for horse games starts.



#### Climate of Kyrgyzstan

The climate conditions of Kyrgyzstan determined by its geographical location. The Kyrgyzstan territory covers an area of 197.5 thousand km2 and 90% of the territory are mountainous. Only about 20% of the republic's territory has areas with comfortable living conditions. The majority of the population lives in this zone and economic activity is concentrated here. About half of the territory is uncompensated discomfort, only mining enterprises are permanently operating, and other economic activities are seasonal.

The natural-climatic conditions of mountainous Kyrgyzstan divided into four natural-climatic zones:

The valley-piedmont belt (900 - 1200 meters) characterized by hot summers, moderately cool and snowless winters. Average temperature in July is 20-25°C, Extremely high temperature in summer reaches 44°C and in January -4 -7°C, absolute minimums in winter are -22-30°C, in some places - 40°C.

The middle-mountainous belt (900-2200 m) has a typical mild climate with warm, relatively sufficient moisture in summer and moderately cold snowy winter. The average temperature in July is +18+19°C, in January -7...-8°C.

The high-mountainous belt (2200 - 3500 m) characterized by cool summer and cold snowy winter. The average temperature in July  $+11 +16^{\circ}$ C, in January  $-8 -10^{\circ}$ C. Winter is long (November-March).

The Nival belt (3500 m and above) characterized by a severe, very cold climate. It is a belt of snow, rocks, glaciers and moisture accumulation belt. Even in the lower part of this belt, average July temperatures do not exceed  $+4 + 7^{\circ}$ C, and January temperatures fall to  $-19 - 22^{\circ}$ C of frost.

## Alpine lake Son-Kul

Son-Kul is a large alpine lake, sandwiched in a hollow between the inner spurs of the Tien Shan, is located between the Sonkol-Too and Moldo-Too ridges, at an altitude of 3,016 above sea level in the northwestern part of Naryn Province (Kyrgyzstan). It is a potential object for ecological tourism. Around the lake, there are unspoiled and saturated grassland and a protected Nature reserve area.

The total area of the lake mirror is 278 km<sup>2</sup>, fresh water volume 2.4 km<sup>3</sup>, length 28 km, width 18 km. The average depth is 8.6 m, maximum about 14 m. The basin of the lake is of tectonic origin. The shores of the lake are low, the coastline is slightly rugged, swamped and in some places overgrown with reeds. Small streams and rivers flow into the Son-Kul Lake with glacial feeding, and one river, the Son-Kul, flows out into the Naryn River (largest river of Kyrgyzstan). Ice cover on the lake from the end of September to the end of May. Flora and fauna: Valuable fish species such

as the pellet, as well as rare carp species such with very limited habitat inhabit the lake. The lake is an important migration point for waterfowl such as the handsome crane, mountain goose, black stork and black headed laughingstock.




#### Roads of Kyrgyzstan

The total length of the country's roads about 34,000 km, including 1,821.16 km of public roads (including 4089.70 km of international roads, 5,621.50 km of national roads and 9,109.96 km of local roads). The length of paved roads is 17 071.93 km.

A significant part of the internal road network runs through mountainous areas and through rural settlements as well as provides access to transport corridors and connects provinces, towns and villages. There are so many mountain passes, and smooth alpine meadows, perfect route for adventurous biking and mountain biking.

Biking on car and paved roads gives the opportunity travel all over the country to learn more about nature, people and local customs. Kyrgyzstan is the best place to go in this regard. The indigenous culture and traditions are worthy of being introduced on a biking tour, as well as to get the opportunity to fully relax in nature.




#### Baku

The capital city of Azerbaijan, Baku, from every year is becoming more and more a modern and western style metropolis. Baku has many theatres, museums, wide boulevards and squares, a lot of greenery, shopping and entertainment centers, cozy restaurants, where you can spend an evening. There are a lot of restaurants in the center, where you will find dolma, kutabs, dovga, bozbash, dushbara, lula-kebab and other dishes.

In the «Baku Acropolis» Icheri Sheher the oldest buildings date back to the 7th-8th centuries, among them the Baba-Kukhi-Bakuva Mosque and Maiden Tower. The magnificent Shirvanshahs' palace and the mosque with the Synig-Gala minaret belong to the Middle Ages. The largest in CIS complex of tombs, cave fortresses and rock paintings up to 10 thousand years old called Gobustan is located an hour's drive from Baku. It is also interesting to see the Bukhara caravanserai, built in the 15th century, on the trade route that passed through the Shemakha Gate.



Snow leopard one of the main symbols of mountainous Kyrgyzstan, it is an interesting predator and is the only subspecies of large cats living in high mountainous conditions. The snow leopard lives in the mountain systems of Tien Shan, Altay, Himalayas, Hindu Kush and Pamir. Today, there are between 4,000 and 7,000 species left in the world. The snow leopard has the status of a rare or endangered species in all countries of their natural habitat. Hunting for the snow leopard strictly forbidden, and are listed in the international as well as



Kyrgyzstan rafting tour is a day full of impressions that you will remember and even would like to repeat again. Don't miss your chance to feel a real extreme!



## CONDITIONS

#### HOTEL ACCOMMODATION

**Bishkek:** Hotel "Asia Mountains" provides standard rooms. Hotel is situated in a quite place in the center of Bishkek nearby central mosque. It was built in 2001 year according to a special project,

the main idea of which was to create atmosphere of home comfort with a mix of western architecture and eastern phil osophy. <u>Issyk-Kul:</u> Hotel "Karven Four Seasons" is located on the shore of Issyk-Kul Lake, in the picturesque village of Sary-Oi (Golden Valley) - 244 km. from Bishkek city and 9 km from Cholpon Ata city. It is the first class hotel consisting of standard rooms in the main building and cottages from luxe to presidential suites, designed to accommodate 170 guests. Breakfast is included into rooms' price.

**Karakol:** Hotel "Amir" is a new and comfortable hotel in the center of Karakol. Hotel offers you the following: 18 rooms, including: 5 rooms with king-size beds, 13 rooms with twinsize beds. 4 of the 18 rooms are economy class. Each room has a private toilet and shower and Satellite TV. Hotel provide disposable slippers and

mineral water in every room.

Yurts in Djety-Oguz / Djenish: The yurt camp offers an appealing combination of staying in a typical nomadic dwelling and modern facilities. Here, according to the centuries-old tradition, you will sleep on the floor, not on a bed. Meals are served in the dining yurt where there are no chairs and a dining table, but a low table with plenty of narrow quilts and fur rugs around to sit on. Such details will let you directly experience the culture, traditions and originality of Kyrgyz people. There are 6 Yurts (4-5 pax in each one), 1 large yurtcanteen. There 2 bio toilets (outside) & 2 shower cabins (outside). Please pay your attention that there are only beds (on the floor) with necessary beddings: mattress, blanket, pillow, bed clothes, and rubber hot - water bottle (optional).

To the some mountain area the standard air conditioned transport couldn't drive due to the technical reasons. And normally needed the 4WD transport. A/C coach is forbidden to drive on highway Bishkek-Osh-Bishkek due to the mountain serpentine road and long tunnel 3 km, therefore available only minibuses or vans because of official rules. Air conditioned transport is not available in all outlying regions of Kyrgyzstan and Kazakhstan. F.e. in Osh region for short transit programs. Air conditioned transport will be provided for Uzbekistan portion. **GUIDE SERVICE**

\*Kyrgyz-Chinese border "Torugart" (198 km from Naryn): The border works from Monday till Friday from 10:00 am till 17:00 pm (from Kyrgyz portion, according Kyrgyz time). The border is closed on Saturday-Sunday and official holidays of Kyrgyzstan and China. Lunch time (from Kyrgyz portion): 12:00 am-14:30 pm (Kyrgyz time). Note: it is difference between Kyrgyz and Chinese time in 2 hours.

\*Kyrgyz-Chinese border "Irkeshtam" (250 km from Osh):

The border works from Monday till Friday from 08:00 am till 18:00 pm (Kyrgyz time, GMT+6). The border is closed on Saturday-Sunday and official holidays of Kyrgyzstan and China. Lunch time (from Kyrgyz portion): 12:00 am-14:30 pm (Kyrgyz time).

**Note:** it is difference between Kyrgyz and Chinese time in 2 hours. Drive in comfortable transport (coaches, vans, cars) is not possible, only mountain truck or 4WD transport can drive this route. Because of long driving time we suggest making a break and overnight in Yurts / local housing in Sary-Tash. The next day after crossing Irkeshtam border continue

driving to Kashgar. The Chinese side of the road is asphalted and in good condition.

\*Kyrgyz-Kazakh border "Ak-Jol" (Kordai) (25 km from Bishkek): The border works 24 hours round.

\*Kyrgyz-Kazakh border «Kegen» (Karkara valley): Karkara crossing opens only in summer, approximately mid-May to end of October, from 9 am to 6 pm. In 2014, it opened on May 19th, in 2015 on May 13th. In 2016, it closed on October 30th.

\*Kyrgyz-Kazakh border "Chaldobar" (91 <u>km from Bishkek):</u> The border works 24 hours round.

\*Kyrgyz-Uzbek border "Dostuk" (15 km from Osh): The border operates every day from 8:00am till 18:00pm (Kyrgyz time).

\*Kyrgyz-Tajik border "Kyzyl-Art" (225 km from Osh): The border operates every day.

\*Kazakh-Chinese border "Khorgos" (420 km from Almaty): A year round road between Almaty and Urumchi via the border post at Khorgos. Distance - 420 km (6-7 hrs), (Khorgos is 40 km east of Zharkent (Panfilov) and about 4 km west of the border. Zharkent, 340 km by road north-east of Almaty). Border opens from Monday till Friday, from 09:00 am till 18:00 pm, lunch time 12:00 pm-14:30 pm. The border does not work on Saturday -Sunday and national holidays of Kazakhstan and China. There are a Kazakh customs and immigration post, a foreign exchange bank and Khorgos hotel at Khorgos border.

\*Kazakh-Uzbek border "Chernyaevka" (590 km, from Bishkek, 20 km from Tashkent): The border works 24 hours round. Lunch time: 13:00-14:00 pm (Kazakh time) TREK

The tourists should have warm clothes, gloves, eye glasses with sides' protection, good footwear. Clients will carry their daypacks. During the trek we will provide also porters and trek guide.


